Enjoy a story read to you by a grown-up.	Use the ' all about numbers 13 and 14 ' sheets to draw and count the amounts to 11/12.	Can you draw a picture of your favourite part of the Billy Goats Gruff Story?
Keep a diary of what you have done each day. Can you draw pictures and write some words or captions.	Find 20 objects from around the house. Can you use the online dice https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9L-VhUmir-A to take away the amount of items shown on the dice. Can you record your answers in a number sentence?	The weather is warming up now, and we can start to see some signs of Spring. Can you draw a picture of some of the changes in weather that you have noticed?
Practise reading the green words. If you can read the words with set 1 sounds try to read the set 2 words.	Find 10 objects from around the house. Can you use the online dice https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9L-VhUmir-A to add the amount of items shown on the dice. Can you record your answers in a number sentence?	Can you use recycled materials from around the house to make a model of a troll, bridge, billy goat or even all 3.
Practice counting from 1 to 20.	Pick out a number flash card at random, can you find one more and one less by using a number line ? How can you record your answers?	It is World Book Day this week. Can you dress up as your favourite book character and draw a picture of yourself? Can you write a sentence about your costume?
Practise writing your numbers to 20 using the number rhymes to help you.	Solve the problems on the addition and subtraction puzzle sheet to help you colour in the picture. Can you use objects to help you? Can you work the answers out by counting on a number line ?
