


Hythe and Dymchurch (Year 1) Home Learning Grid, Term 2

<p>Complete at least 1 activity per week.</p> <p><i>Remember you can draw, write, build, collage, etc.</i></p>	<p>Read 'Jack and the Flum Flum Tree' by Julia Donaldson at home (or watch it on YouTube). Write about it and draw your favourite part. (Or choose a different story by Julia Donaldson)</p>	<p>Learn a poem to help us remember Bonfire night and Guy Fawkes. Write it out and add drawings to decorate it. Lots of 'fire' colours would be great.</p>	<p>Write out and learn all the different ways to make 7 using addition, e.g. $7 + 0 = 7$ $5 + 2 = 7$</p>	<p>Draw or paint a snail- add a fact or two about snails for our research centre/class pets.</p>
	<p>Find a recipe for salt dough and make some at home. Make a snail or a whale. Bring your snail/whale in or take pictures of you making the salt dough.</p>	<p>Draw a picture of today's weather. Write at least one sentence to describe the weather.</p>	<p>Complete these number sentences and use some objects to practise taking away and find how many are left. $9 - 4 = ?$ $12 - 7 = ?$ $10 - 6 = ?$ $15 - 4 = ?$ Now do some of your own.</p>	<p>2D shapes- draw a range of items in your house, what shapes are they? Can you write the shape names?</p>
	<p>Learn weekly spellings. (See separate sheet for guidance.)</p>	<p>Make a list of all the things that Granny put in the sack for Jack. Draw some of them.</p>	<p>Design a waterproof coat for Jack to keep him dry on his journey.</p>	<p>Draw a simple map of your route to school. What do you see along the way?</p>
	<p>'Invent' your own medicine for Granny. Write out the things you might put in it to make her spots go away. Draw the ingredients and label them.</p>	<p>Make a boat from recycling materials for Jack, Stu, and Rose to travel to the 'Isle of Blowyernose.' What colour will it be? Will it need sails/flags?</p>	<p>Set up a 'shop' with your friend or an adult and practise paying for items using different coins up to 10p or 20p. Take a photograph if possible.</p>	<p>Look at real life objects which are: Cube -? Cuboid - ? Sphere - ? Pyramid? Cylinder? Make a list of the 3D objects.</p>
