Everyday	Maths	Topic
<p>Quickly say some of the sounds on the Sounds Chart. If you are confident with set 1 sounds try set 2 or 3.</p>	<p>Can you share objects into piles equally? Watch the video clips on: <a href="https://www.thenational.academy/online-classroom/reception/maths#subjects">https://www.thenational.academy/online-classroom/reception/maths#subjects</a> Find some objects in your house, can you share them out?</p>	<p>Go for a virtual walk in the forest- <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oSmUI3m2kLk">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=oSmUI3m2kLk</a> Then look out of the window and draw a picture of what you can see. Discuss the similarities and differences between the two environments.</p>
<p>Practise reading and writing some of the high-frequency words.</p>	<p>Can you make a repeating pattern? Find some objects around your house and see if you can make a pattern with them. You could even do some potato printing to make your pattern! Extra challenge: can you make a pattern using three different objects/colours?</p>	<p>If you are able to, plant some seeds in a pot- cress is good as it will grow quickly! Look after your plant and discuss what it needs to grow. <p>Share your reading book with a grown-up or practise reading some of the green words.</p>	<p>Make a ramp and roll some objects/toys down it. Which one went the furthest? Can you use your hands to measure the distance that each item travelled?</p>	<p>Look at some flowers, do they all look the same? How are they similar or different? Can you draw and label the different parts?</p>
<p>Learn some of the model text (Little Red Riding Hood).</p>	<p>Watch the Numberblocks video: <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hhUJV4vDZhY&amp;t=61s">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hhUJV4vDZhY&amp;t=61s</a> Can you count to 20? See if you can find 20 objects and practise counting them accurately. Extra challenge: split them into pairs and count in 2s.</p>	<p>Can you design your own forest and cottage? You could draw, paint or use collage materials!</p>

<p>Write a shopping list so Little Red Riding Hood knows what to take to Grandma’s house. Remember to write using the sounds you can hear in the words i.e. ‘apl (apple) cayk (cake) joos (juice).’</p>	<p><b>Make a wanted poster to help find the wolf. Can you use adjectives to describe him?</b></p> <p><b>Use the story map template to make up your own story. Label each picture with captions/words.</b></p>	<p>Tasks set on Purple Mash:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Design a garden. Can you add some flowers to your garden and describe them?</li> <li>- Make a bouquet of flowers, ensuring each flower is different. Can you discuss their features and how they differ?</li> </ul>
<p>Handwriting- see if you can copy the high frequency words, forming the letters correctly. Try and write the words on the line.</p>	<p>Write a simple version of your story. See if you can use story telling vocabulary such as ‘once upon a time, one day, suddenly, happily ever after’. Remember to write using the sounds you can hear in the words i.e. ‘the dighnosor et a chicn.’</p>	<p>Play Phonics Pop- <a href="https://www.ictgames.com/phonicsPop/index.html">https://www.ictgames.com/phonicsPop/index.html</a> Choose 3 sounds that you don’t already know and see if you can learn them.
