Practise your times tables every day.**

<b>Complete at least 1 activity every day and colour the activity you have done.</b>	<b>Diary</b> Write a diary entry for each day you should be in school. Draw a picture for each day.	<b>Spring Maths</b> Work through Spring maths activities, pages 2-7. <b>Spring Maths Activities, pages 2,3,4,5,6,7</b>	<b>Fact Sheet</b> Make a fact sheet on exercise at home. Remember to use Headings, Sub-headings, Diagrams, Bullet Points, Lists.	<b>Maths Problems</b> Work through <b>Division Word Problems 1</b> .
	<b>Letter NHS</b> Did you applaud on Thursday 26 <sup>th</sup> ? Write a letter to an NHS key worker, (doctor, nurse, paramedic), to say thank you for their hard work at this time.	<b>Clock</b> Draw a clock and explain how to tell the time, on the hour, quarter past, half past and quarter to. Challenge yourself and explain the minutes more precisely.	<b>Poem</b> Write a shape poem about your favourite animal. Draw the outline then fill the body with your poetry.	<b>Handwriting</b> Practise your joined handwriting. Use the <b>High Frequency Word Handwriting Booklet</b> .
	<b>Spelling</b> Continue to work on your <b>High Frequency Word sheet</b> . Choose 3 words every day and learn to read and write them. Make up a sentence containing this word. <b>Check</b> - does it make sense? Have I used a capital letter and a full stop or question mark?	<b>Money</b> Set up a shop and pay for toys. (You could put price tags on your toys). Can you add amounts up to 50p? Can you add amounts up to £1? Can you find change from 50p and £1?	<b>Poster</b> Remember the story "Troll Stinks"? Billy and Cyril were mean to baby troll. Make a poster to explain how to keep safe online.	<b>Song</b> At school we practised singing 'Happy Birthday' twice whilst washing our hands so we knew we were washing them for 20 seconds. Use the "Happy Birthday" tune and make up your own song about washing your hands.
	<b>Times tables</b> Practise your tables (including your division facts). Sing them, write them, test your adults! Use online games such as 'Hit The Button'.
