	<p>Create a poster or write about why your family is just right for you.</p>	<p>Learn the alphabet song and sing it to an adult in class. Bring it to school.</p>	<p>Draw a picture showing all the different signs of Autumn and label it.</p>
	<p>Design/make a texture board. How many different textures can you feel and describe?</p>	<p>Thank you to those who have already passed on a family photo. If possible, send in a family photo to your child's new teacher. Or you could email one to the office.</p>	<p>Write a list of all the things you can do now that you couldn't do when you were a baby.</p>	<p>Design/create a spaceship for Beegu with recycling items. Bring it to school.</p>
	<p>Paint/make a picture of your favourite day or event in the Summer holidays. Your picture needs to show what the weather was like on that day. Where did you go? Who did you go with? What did you do?</p>	<p>Write two lists of foods you like and foods you don't like.</p>	<p>Practise counting to 100 with an adult at home. Then count to 100 to an adult in school to show your learning. Perhaps you can also try counting backwards?</p>	<p>Make a 'Smell Book'; show pictures of different smells on each page. Write if you think each smell is nice/horrible. Try to find different words that are similar to nice/ horrible to describe the smells.</p>
